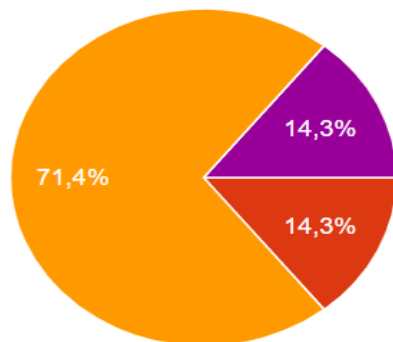
Forming a network of towns, european towns, it was a great idea. Most important, is to used that friendship, for further project, to continue to build the network and idea , to continue this friendship.

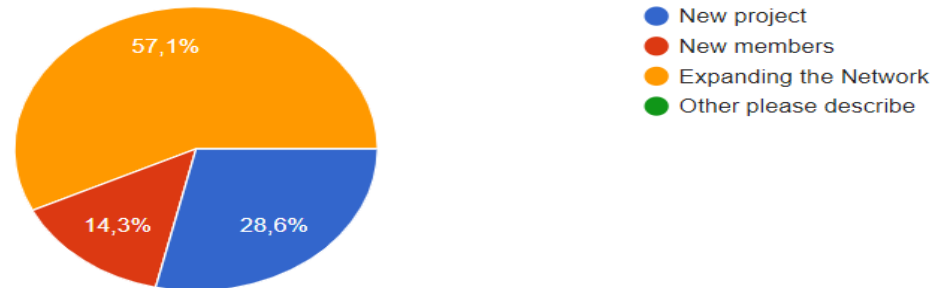

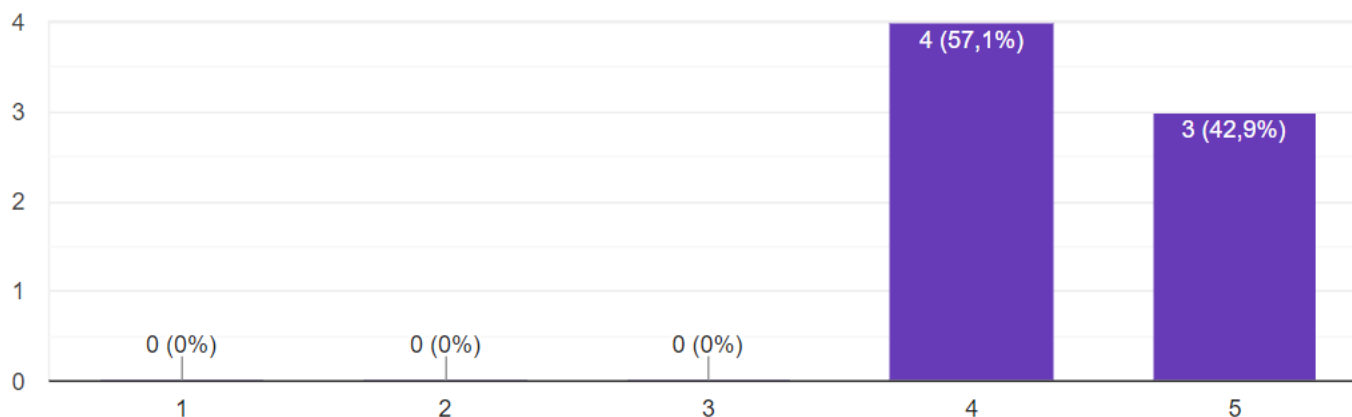

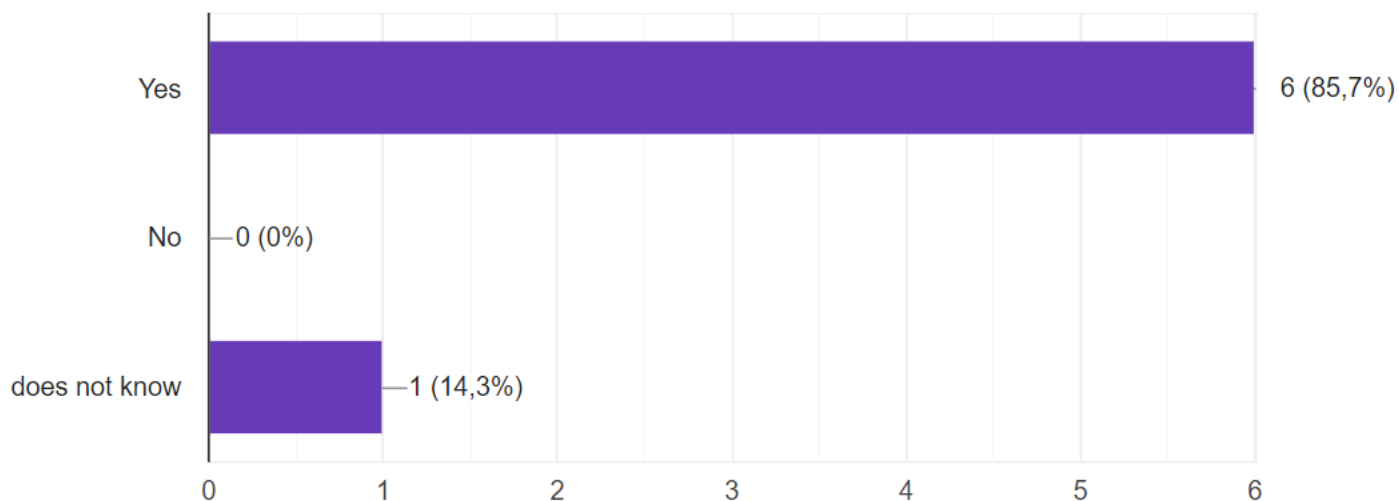

We are thinking about implementation some project concerning youngsters.

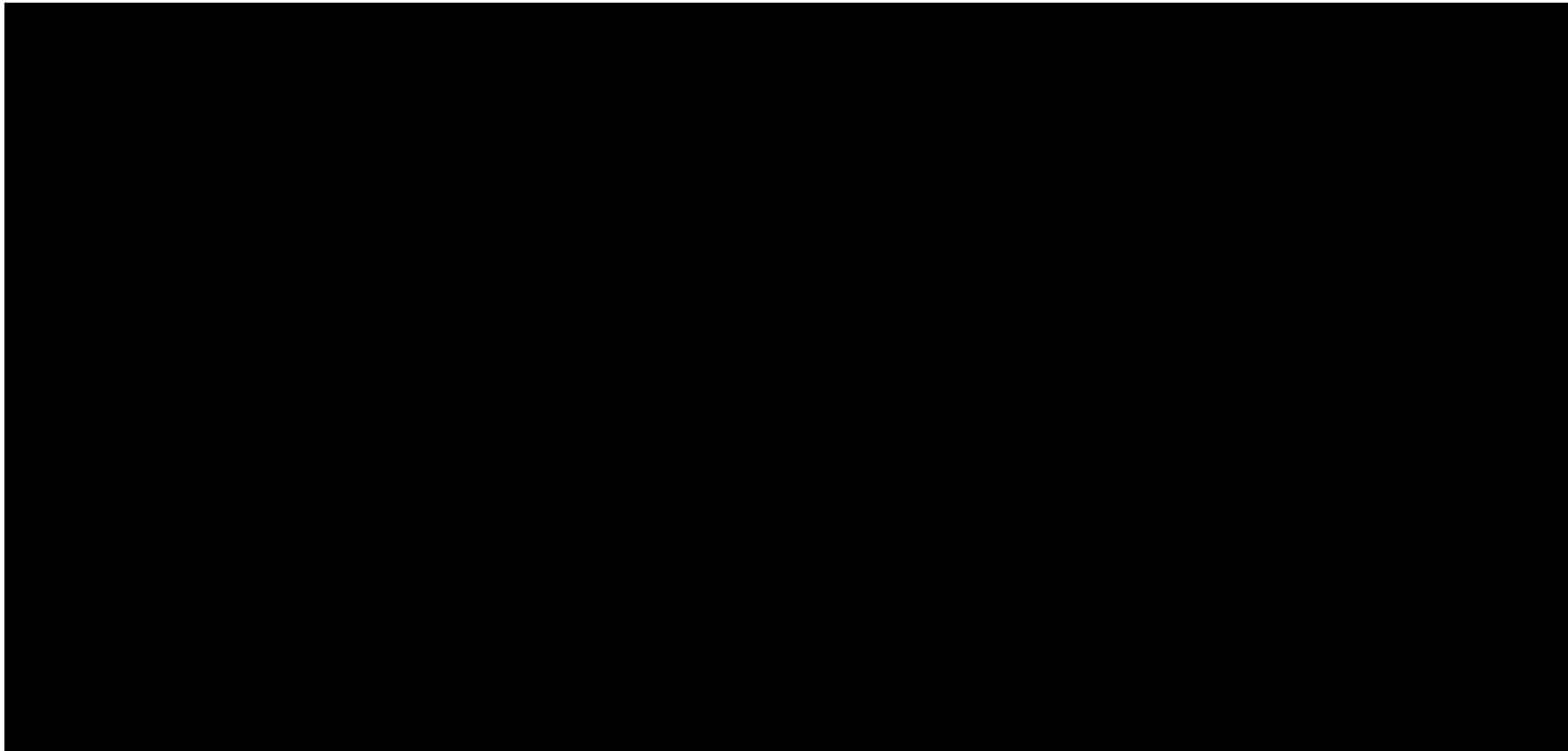
